Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County, on **February 16, 2012** at 10:00 AM, prevailing time at the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County's office, 500 Mt. Pisgah Avenue, Post Office Box 587, Oxford, New Jersey 07863-0587, at which time and place bids will be opened and read in public for:

BIDS WILL BE RECEIVED BY MAIL OR HAND DELIVERY. The Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County **will not** be responsible for Bid Packages **not arriving** at the time and place designated. Specifications, Instructions to Bidders and Bid Forms may be obtained at the offices of Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County, 500 Mt. Pisgah Avenue, Post Office Box 587, Oxford, New Jersey 07863-0587, during regular business hours (Monday - Friday 8:30 AM - 3:30 PM) beginning January 30, 2012. All questions regarding the Specifications, Instructions to Bidders and Bid Forms should be submitted, in writing, to James Williams, Director of Operations.

Bids will be on the forms provided in the bid package in the manner designated therein and addressed to the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County, 500 Mt. Pisgah Avenue, Post Office Box 587, Oxford, New Jersey 07863-0587, and clearly marked on the outside "**BID FURNISHING CONTRACTOR SERVICES FOR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAYS 2012.**" Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bond in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid, but not to exceed \$20,000.00, payable to the **Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County.**

The Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County (the "PCFAWC") reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the Bid received and to accept the bids which in their judgment will serve the best interest of Warren County and the PCFAWC.

All Bidders must comply with the mandatory requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-3.1 et seq. (P.L. 1975, c. 127) regarding Affirmative Action responsibilities of contractors. The Prevailing Wage Act (when applicable) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.25 et seq. successful bidders on projects for public work shall adhere to all requirements of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act.

Bids by Corporations and Partnerships shall include a completed Disclosure of Ownership Form as required by State Law (Chapter 33 of Public Laws of 1977).

The Non-Collusion Affidavit, which is part of these specifications, shall be properly executed and submitted with the bid proposal.

The PCFAWC reserves the right to reject any or all bids due to any defects or waive informalities and accept any bid that in its judgment will be in the best interest of the PCFAWC and reserves the right to sever and make awards of all parts of any bids to one or more bidder(s). The PCFAWC shall award contract or reject all bids no later than sixty (60) days from receipt of same.

The PCFAWC reserves the right to reject any or all bids if deemed to the best interest of the Pollution Control Financing Authority of Warren County to do so.
